# Dr. Muhammad Romman has taken charge as a Deputy Director at ORIC.

Dr. Muhammad Romman assumed the charge of Deputy Director of the Office of Research, Innovation, and Commercialization (ORIC) at the University of Chitral on Octuber 11th, 2021. Dr. Ishfaq Hameed, Head of the Department of Botany, and Dr. Tahir Mehmood, from the Department of Economics at the University of Chitral, were also in present at the ceremony where he took charge.

The Directorate of ORIC at the University of Chitral organized a National seminar on the topic of "Integrity, Sustainability, and Future Prospective of Olive in Pakistan" in collaboration with the Pakistan Oilseed Department on 26/12/2021

The event was graced by Prof. Dr. Zahir Shah, the Vice Chancellor of the University of Chitral, who served as the Chief Guest. Dr. Muhammad Romman, Deputy Director ORIC, was also present on the occasion. The program started with the recitation of verses from the Holy Quran, followed by a welcome address by Dr. Khair Muhammad, Managing Director of the Pakistan Oilseed Department. He highlighted the fast-growing trend of olive plantation in Pakistan, given the favorable environmental conditions. He also mentioned that Chitral, being one of the few districts in KP, has the potential to become a hub for olive plantation. Moreover, he announced an internship program for Botany students from the University of Chitral in the Pakistan Oilseed Department.

Eminent scientists from different provinces of Pakistan presented their research papers on olive cultivation in Pakistan. Dr. Muhammad Ramzan Anser, an agronomist at the Centre of Excellence for Olive Research and Training at Barani Agriculture Research Institute Chakwal, presented his research paper on an integrated model for promoting and developing the value chain of olive cultivation in Pakistan. He explained that his department is working towards the promotion and development of the olive industry in Pakistan. Mr. Inam Ul Haq, the project incharge for the Balochistan component, gave a detailed presentation on the current scenario of olive cultivation in the Balochistan province. Dr. Syed Asghar, the project in-charge at ARI Tarnab Peshawar, shared the history and current status of olive cultivation in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and mentioned that 30 acres of land has been cultivated with olive trees in Chitral. Dr. Muhammad Azhar Iqbal, a horticulturist at the Centre of Excellence for Olive Research and Training at Barani Agriculture Research Institute Chakwal, presented his paper on successful olive cultivation in relation to varietal selection and production technology under Pothwar Agro-climatic conditions of Pakistan. Mr. Nadeem Sadiq, the Director-General of Balochistan Agriculture Research Institute, presented his research paper on the sustainability and future prospects of olive cultivation in Balochistan. Dr. Azmat Ali Awan, the Deputy National Project Director of Pakistan Oilseed Department, gave a detailed presentation on the olive sector in Pakistan. The conference was attended by students, faculty members, representatives from the forest department, Agriculture Research Station Chitral, Agriculture Extension Department Chitral, and Soil Conservation Department Chitral.















On March 15, 2024, the University of Chitral observed Tree Plantation Day under the theme of "Let's Nurture the Nature so that we can have a better future".

The Department of Botany organized the program under the supervision of the Directorate of ORIC. The program began with recitation of verses from the Holy Quran. Mr. Hafeez Ullah, a lecturer in the Department of Botany, hosted the stage. Mr. Nadeem Hassan, Additional Director Administration, welcomed the guests. The Chief Guest of the program was Mr. Anwar Ul HaQ, Deputy Commissioner of Lower Chitral. The Vice Chancellor of the University of Chitral, Prof. Dr. Zahir Shah, was the Guest of Honor. Towards the end of the program, tree saplings were distributed among the students and staff of the University of Chitral.

The University of Chitral collaborated with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Centre of Excellence on Countering Violent Extremism and Paigham e Pakistan Center for Peace, Reconciliation and Reconstruction Studies, Islamic Research Institute, and International Islamic University Islamabad to organize a one-day National Youth Conference titled "Paigham e Pakistan". The conference featured prominent guest speakers such as Dr. Abdu Rehman Khalil, Assistant Professor at the University of Peshawar, Dr. Abdul Moheman from the University of Haripur, Muhammad Israr Madani, President of the International Research Council for Religious Affairs, and Dr. Kashif Irshad, Director of KP Countering Violent Extremism. During the conference, the speakers emphasized that Paigham e Pakistan is a message of peace and unity, which is a joint statement of the scholars of all schools of thought. They also pointed out that it is the most important document in the history of Pakistan after the resolution. 

## IN PIECES:

FOOD IS MORE FILLING WHEN PRE-CUT INTO PIECES

### **ABSTRACT**

To investigate if cutting a food into pieces has an effect on satiety, students were given a bagel that was either (1) whole, (2) cut into 4 pieces which were kept together, or (3) cut into 4 pieces which were spread out. A general linear model revealed that overall satiety was the highest when food was cut into pieces, but only when the pieces were kept together.

### **OBJECTIVES**

- Is food more filling when people receive it pre-cut into several pieces?
- Is it the space the pieces fill on the plate or the number of pieces that increase satiety?



### **METHODS**

- 43 college students
- Asked to finish a mini bagel with cream cheese
- · Assigned to 1 of 3 conditions:



 Measured hunger, fullness, and satiety levels on 9-point likert scales

# OVERALL SATIETY 2.18 3.75 4.77 2.18 3.75 4.77

# CONCLUSIONS

- Participants reported greater satiety when eating a food that was cut into several pieces, but only when those pieces remained close together.
- We suspect that cutting a food into several pieces increases safiety because it increases the number of units being eaten, hence increasing the psychological sense of satiety.
- However, if the food is spread out, its volume might appear lower, therefore countering the positive effects of eating pieces.



This event was organized to train students and faculty members of the University of Chitral on kitchen gardening. The training was conducted by Dr. Muhammad Naseer, a Senior Research Officer at Agriculture Research Station, Chitral. It was held under the leadership of the Vice Chancellor of the university, Prof. Dr. Zahir Shah, who is committed to improving the research position of the university worldwide. The purpose of the training was to promote organic vegetable production for home use without the use of pesticides and chemicals. Additionally, it aimed to encourage research and innovative skills among the students of Chitral University. The event was organized by Dr. Ishfaq Hameed, convener of the oversight committee, and Dr. Syed Fahad Ali Shah, member of the oversight committee. More than 21 faculty members and 201 students of the University of Chitral attended the training. Members of the GYM club were also present at the event. Dr. Muhammad Abdul Rauf, Director of Agricultural Research Station, Chitral Lower, addressed the students, highlighting the benefits of kitchen gardening with special emphasis on heavy metal-free vegetables for the Chitral region. He emphasized that market vegetables are grown in areas that are irrigated with polluted water, which brings negative health effects. Dr. Syed Fahad Ali Shah, HOD of the Economics department, also addressed the students and explained that the agricultural sector plays a very important role in sustainable economic growth.
